

Elloughton-cum-Brough Town Council – Administration

The Town Council is a 12 member Council, supported by four Committees:

- Development, Planning, Highways and Safety Committee
- Village Environment Committee
- Arts, Publicity and Fundraising Committee
- Administration and Finance Committee.

Employees of the Council are the Town Clerk Mrs Jane Smith who works full-time and Mrs Vicky Herring, the Deputy Town Clerk who averages 22 hours per week. The Council also employs a playground worker for 6 hours per week who attends the play area every week day morning for at least one hour to carry out litter picking, graffiti clearing and gardening.

Development, Planning, Highways and Safety Committee

This committee deals with planning application consultations, tree application consultations and development, highways and safety issues.

Village Environment Committee

This committee deals with all matters relating to the environment of the villages such as:

- maintenance of the public rights of way, snickets and footpaths
- Elloughton Road Play Area
- Street Furniture: seats, litter bins, notice boards
- Several areas of open space including the land surrounding the Village Hall

Arts, Publicity and Fundraising Committee

This committee organises events such as the Annual Art Exhibition and Children's Christmas Tree Festival and produces the parish map, the walks leaflet and the Petuaria Press, the Town Council's quarterly newsletter.

Administration and Finance Committee

This committee deals with staffing and recommends the annual Precept to the full Council.
